Member Commitments

As a CSA member, you commit to:

Understanding the nature of sustainable farming, which may mean that occasionally produce has some cosmetic damage, and that seasonality, productivity, and possible crop failures may mean that certain veggies are not always available;

Picking up your boxes at the appointed time and place, or having a friend/family member pick it up for you. Due to the lack of cold storage at the farm, we will not be able to store boxes after the pick up date.
